

Trauma Nursing Core Course TNCC

Purpose: The Trauma Core Course presents core-level knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with implementing the trauma nursing process. This course enhances the nurse's ability to assess, rapidly and accurately, the patient responses to the process. The skill stations facilitate integration of psychomotor abilities in a setting that simulates trauma patient situations. Topic include biomechanics and mechanism of injury, initial assessment, shock, thoracic, abdominal, spinal cord, burn, geriatric and pediatric trauma, and psychosocial aspects of trauma. The skills stations cover the trauma nursing process, airway and ventilation interventions, spinal immobilization, traction application and chest trauma.
